Family Camp Dinner Line Helpful Upgrades: We appreciate the feedback we receive and continue looking for ways to make Family Camp welcoming and comfortable for everyone. This year, **families with children ages 4 and under, Golden Years campers (75+), and those with medical concerns** are encouraged to use the west-side dining hall food line (for lunch and dinner). Our hope is that this will provide a quicker serving experience, reduce wait times, and help those who may have difficulty standing in longer lines or spending extended time in the heat.

Continued Opportunities for Adults of Every Stage of Life

One of the highlights of Family Camp 2025 was the strong participation in our adult classes. Many participants appreciated having smaller, more personal spaces to share life experiences, build relationships, and explore faith together. Because of that positive response, we will continue a similar format in 2026.

While all classes will connect with our reunion theme, "The Mission Prayer – A Way of Life," each group will explore how the theme intersects with the opportunities, responsibilities, and experiences people encounter in different seasons of life.

Young Adult & Mid-Life Adult Class (10:00–11:45 a.m.)

Facilitators: Larry McGuire, Sherry Corder & Kathy Darnell – Tabernacle

Designed primarily for adults in their 20s through 50s, this class will focus on integrating the daily Family Camp themes into the realities of everyday life. Through conversation and reflection, participants will explore topics such as family, careers, relationships, faith journeys, personal challenges, and opportunities to become a blessing in the communities where they live and serve.

Throughout the week, Seventy Larry McGuire will spend time with the class, offering insights and helping connect the reunion themes to the experiences shared by participants.

Testimonies of Blessing (10:00–11:45 a.m.)

Designed especially for those 50 and older, though everyone is welcome, this class responds to requests for more opportunities to share stories of faith, encouragement, and God's presence throughout life's journey. Participants will gather in a welcoming environment to reflect on blessings received, lessons learned, and the ways God continues to work in and through ordinary lives. **Larry McGuire will also spend time** with this class during the week, enriching conversations and helping connect testimonies to the reunion theme.

McGuire New for 2026, Larry McGuire will offer a daily afternoon gathering designed to go deeper into the reunion theme. Through storytelling, reflection, discussion, and spiritual insight, participants will explore "the rest of the story" behind the Mission Prayer and discover practical ways to live its invitation each day. This afternoon format also provides an excellent opportunity for those with morning responsibilities to participate and offers a comfortable indoor setting during the warmest part of the day.

Sr. High Youth: A Fresh Approach

Morning Session (10:00–11:45 a.m.) Using a creative, interactive, and youth-centered approach, participants will explore each day's Family Camp theme and discover how the Mission Prayer speaks to the real-life experiences they face. Through conversation, activities, reflection, and fellowship, youth will be challenged to recognize God's presence in their lives and find meaningful ways to become a blessing to others wherever they live, learn, and serve.

Evening Session (9:30–10:30 p.m.)

Brendan Cary will lead a time of fellowship, learning, discussion, and fun as youth build relationships and explore what it means to live the Mission Prayer in today's world.
